

Eight Prophetic Probabilities

(out of over 300 OT prophecies, all fulfilled by Christ)

Prophecies:	Probabilities:
1. Born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2)	1:100,000
2. Death by Crucifixion (Psalm 22:16)	1:10,000
3. Hailed as a King Riding a Donkey (Zechariah 9:9)	1:100
4. Betrayed for 30 Pieces of Silver (Zechariah 11:12)	1:1,000
5. Transaction Took Place in the Temple / Silver to the Potter (Zech. 11:13)	1:100,000
6. Wounded in His Hands in the House of His Friends (Zechariah 13:6)	1:1,000
7. Made No Defense Though Innocent (Isaiah 53:7)	1:1,000
8. Died With the Wicked, Grave With the Rich (Isaiah 53:9)	1:1,000

The probability that one man would fulfill all eight →

$$10^5 \times 10^4 \times 10^2 \times 10^3 \times 10^5 \times 10^3 \times 10^3 \times 10^3 = 10^{28}$$

/ 8.8×10^{10} (the estimated number of people who have lived between the time these prophecies were given, until now)

$$= 1 \text{ chance in } 100,000,000,000,000,000 (10^{17})$$
